hilarious sketches mixed with video shorts



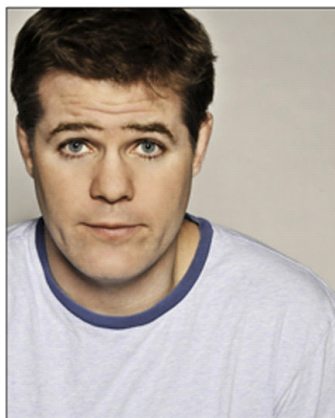
All you need to pull off a show is:
